If you wish to attend the City Council meeting in person, the City Council Chambers will be open for this meeting and the public shall have the right to observe and offer public comment at this location. While you may attend this meeting in person, given the health risks associated with COVID-19, the City wants you to know that you can submit your comments and questions in writing for City Council consideration by sending them to the City Clerk at <u>cityclerk@santafesprings.org</u>. To give the City Council adequate time to review your questions and comments, please submit your written comments prior to 4:00 p.m. on the day of the City Council meeting.

If you have travelled internationally and/or you have had direct contact with someone who has travelled internationally or tested positive for Coronavirus (COVID-19), or you are experiencing symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, fever, difficulty breathing or other flu-like symptoms, please DO NOT ATTEND this meeting in person.

If you are in the group of individuals who may be most vulnerable to COVID-19, including those over the age of 65 and those with underlying health conditions, including but not limited to lung, heart, immune-compromised, diabetes, or other conditions that could interfere with your ability to fight COVID-19, please consider carefully before attending this meeting in person and keep a sixfoot distance from others as much as possible.
