#### **RECOMMENDATION**

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Art Education Grant Program is facilitated by the HAAC in an advisory capacity. Funded by the Heritage Arts in Public Places program, the Heritage Arts Education Endowment Fund was established to support youth oriented arts programs and events with Art Education Grants. Schools in Santa Fe Springs have the opportunity to submit applications annually requesting funds to help support their art education programs.

The HAAC received a total of 27 Art Education Grant applications for FY 2022-23 for review and approval. Each HAAC member received a binder with copies of these applications following the meeting in June 2022. The HAAC had one month to review these applications. All Art Education Grant program applications will be discussed and approved at the HAAC meeting on July 26, 2026. The HAAC, with staff assistance, will then submit the approved qualified applications to the Santa Fe Springs City Council for funding approval at a future council meeting.

### **Summer Movie and Concert Series @Heritage Park 2022 Planning**

The Summer Movie and Concert Series at Heritage Park is close to wrapping up with one more movie and concert for the 2022 series. The schedule for the events is as follows:

- Movie: Luca, Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, 8:15 p.m.
- Concert: Mariachi Las Colibri, Friday, August 5, 7:00 p.m.

### **Summer Arts and Crafts Camp**

Heritage Park is offering a Summer Arts and Crafts camp to allow children to tap into their inner artists. Children ages 7-11 will enjoy creating various pieces of art through drawing, painting, and crafting in this indoor/outdoor art experience. Art Camp is \$75 per week per child and includes all art supplies for the session. The next available session is August 1 – August 5 from 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. Children must bring a sack lunch. ### **Heritage Park Café**

Family and Human Services Staff is currently working with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health to obtain permits to re-open the Heritage Park Café to sell bottled beverages and pre-packaged items to park goers. The plan is to re-open the café Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. and open during special events such as the Summer Movie and Concert Series. If all goes well with the Health Department application, we hope to re-open the Café by the end of July 2022.

### **Student Internship Program**

The Family & Human Services Division partners with local universities to provide undergraduate social work students with valuable fieldwork experience working with families, older adults, and the community at large. Every year, we partner with the California State University System to host Social Work Interns at the Gus Velasco Neighborhood Center. Student interns are trained and coached by our Family and Human Services Caseworkers, which provide hands-on instruction to guided case management services, integration of classwork with fieldwork, and assist to provide service to the community. This coming August we have one student intern scheduled to begin in late August from the California State University, Long Beach.

## **City Volunteer Program**

The City offers a variety of volunteer opportunities. As part of becoming an ongoing volunteer, applicants must undergo a Live Scan background check and provide a current Tuberculosis (TB) test result which is good for 4 years. One recent change to the program is the City is now paying for TB testing. In previous years, it was the responsibility of the volunteer to provide proof of a current vaccination. 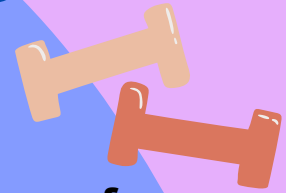
