

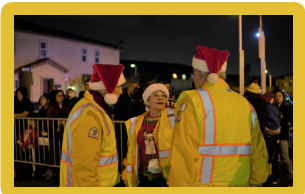


Volunteer Opportunities:

STEPS TO VOLUNTEERING

- Submit an application and waiver release form.
- Pass a background check*. Referral will be provided to volunteer. *Applies to applicants 18 and older.
- Provide TB test clearance.
- Must attend a volunteer orientation meeting. Date will be provided upon volunteer application clearance.
- Obtain a volunteer identification from Community Services staff.

Adult Volunteer Opportunities

You can support the City of Santa Fe Springs by becoming a volunteer. Adults over the age of 18 interested in giving back to their community can help at different events throughout the year. Volunteers can also choose to support a specific department and/or program. As a volunteer you'll have the opportunity to use your strengths, passions and experiences to help the residents of our City.



Teen Volunteer Opportunities

High school students between the ages of 14 - 17 are encouraged to become a volunteer. They can serve their community in a variety of ways at city-wide events or to support a specific department and/or program. Through their volunteerism they gain the experience and tools to help them develop organization skills, work ethic, and leadership development all while contributing to the community. Youth volunteers also have the opportunity to join the Teens Empowered & Engaged in Neighborhood Services (T.E.E.N.S.) program and participate in different activities including "Fun Nights", development workshops, and guest speaker nights. In addition, they'll have the opportunity to go on trips which include theme parks, beach trips, and appreciation dinners.
