3. **WORKSHOP: A workshop will be held to review and discuss amendments to the following ordinances:**

City Attorney Tim Kirwin spoke about updating the tree preservation and landscaping ordinance and gave an estimated time frame of completion in November.

Tim Kirwin talked about the wording Councilman Koy wants removed from the drainage ordinance. Councilwomen Lerma feels that removing the words "machinery" and "equipment" from the ordinance would affect the city's ability to get funding for future purchases, but does agree with removing the word "furniture".

Lloyd Merrell gave reasons as to why the drainage fee should be increased.

Councilman Burttschell said he has received multiple complaints about the Main Street parking situation. Councilman Koy gave suggestions on how to make the parking signs more noticeable.


