The City of Sealy Prevails in lawsuit by former City Manager

Former City Manager, Lloyd Merrell sued the City for numerous claims in March 2021.

Merrell, who served as the Sealy City Manager from February 2018 to January 2021 announced his resignation as City Manager at a public meeting in December 2020. The City Council accepted and accelerated his resignation. Merrell then filed suit.

The City prevailed at the trial court. Merrell appealed.

The City again prevailed at the appellate court.
