Here are this week's items:

Police Update (from Chief Mcilraith)

- On 01-07-23, Sedro-Woolley Officers were dispatched to a welfare check at 1862 SR 20 in the city of Sedro-Woolley. Officers were advised that a subject there had not been heard from by friends for several days. Officers arrived and found the male in a motel room in severe need of medical assistance. That male was transported to UGH ER for further treatment. The roommate of the male was at the motel room. He admitted that this situation had been going on for multiple days before SWPD got the call from off-site. Upon checking the roommate in our local system, officers found he had multiple warrants for his arrest. He was booked into jail.
- On the afternoon and night of 01-08, SWPD Officers responded to 6 domestic incidents along with other calls for service.
- On 01-09-22, DET MCCOMBS and DET WILSON attended monthly Crisis Negotiations Training. Both are members of the Skagit County Crisis Negotiation Team. Past members have included Lt Sorsdal and Sgt Eaton.
- On 01-09, Sedro-Woolley PD and FD were dispatched to a fire in a building at 240 Bingham Park Loop. Officers arrived to find one of the bathroom's walls had been lit on fire. The fire was reported by a passerby who had seen the smoke. Park staff put the fire out and SWFD assisted further when they arrived. The arson investigation is ongoing, but it does not appear the cameras at the park were functioning.
- On 01-12 and 01-13, SGT EATON attended Internal Affairs Investigation Training.

- Sedro-Woolley Academy – We currently have five applicants, with expectations of a sixth. The application deadline is approaching next Tuesday.
