City Council Schedules Special-Called Meeting to Issue Emergency Ordinance in Response to COVID-19

SEGUIN, Texas – The Seguin City Council will have a special-called meeting at 5:30 pm Tuesday, March 24 to issue an emergency ordinance establishing a city-wide emergency in response to the novel COVID – 19 pandemic.

Citizens will be given time to comment as with regular City Council meetings.

The ordinance calls for the immediate closure of all the following establishments and businesses:

- Bars, wineries, breweries, nightclubs, taverns, lounges
- Restaurant dining rooms (take-out and delivery will remain permitted)
- Health/fitness clubs, gyms, yoga studios
- Game rooms, indoor/outdoor commercial amusement businesses
- Bowling alleys, bingo parlors and movie theaters
- Private clubs
- Nail Salons, Hair Salons, Barber Shops, Beauty Salons and Hair Removal Services
- Spas and Massage Parlors
- Tattoo and Piercing shops
- Other social gatherings, including churches, whether indoor or outdoor, where 10 or more persons congregate and where the business is not providing an essential service
