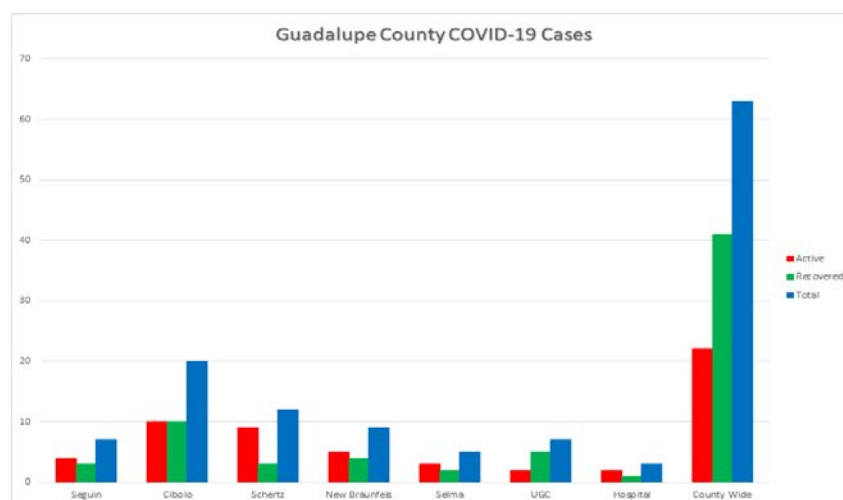
Guadalupe County confirms the 63rd case of COVID-19 with 40 patients now recovered

Four additional COVID-19 cases have been confirmed in Guadalupe County, bringing the total cases to 63. The Texas Department of State Health Services made Guadalupe County Office of Emergency Management aware of these additional cases Monday, April 21, 2020.

The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) also notified Guadalupe County Emergency Management that an additional COVID-19 case was reported yesterday. After conducting an investigation, DSHS advised Emergency Management, the data provided was inaccurate, and they have removed one of the patients from Guadalupe Counties case count.

Guadalupe County currently has 40 recovered patients, 23 active cases, with one patient being hospitalized outside of the County and the second hospitalized patient located in Guadalupe County. Three of today's patients are at home and have been self-quarantined since being tested.

Given the increases in the community spread throughout the United States, all individuals are at some risk of exposures to COVID-19. Everyone should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19, practice social distancing, and stay home if they become sick, except to seek necessary medical care.
