



Knox Box Program Instructions

As more individuals within the senior community choose to live at home rather than move to retirement communities, gaining access during a medical emergency can be an issue for first responders, particularly if an individual has medical or mobility difficulties.

While help is always just a call away, what happens when you cannot come to the door? With a Knox Residential Box, first responders can remove the entrance key stored inside with the Knox Master Key, a high-security master key, and let themselves in to provide medical assistance.

Mail in Instructions

Call (314) 645-5077 to request application, we will mail it same day with our authorization completed. Once received please complete the application, enclose payment and mail to Knox as instructed on application.

In the top right corner click on the red button labeled BUY.

Follow the pop up select Missouri as state, type Shrewsbury as City, click search.

Select the Resident ONLY if resident, all others including multiple resident facilities select other option.

Select the product available for purchase, this product will be owned by you and can be removed from property if vacated. *We cannot guarantee any other jurisdiction will be a participant in the Knox box program. Contact Knox Box for further instructions as needed.

Make product option selection, complete installation address information, and make payment.
