

Engineer Skinner reported the Architect has begun to review how to repurpose the Ender's building into a City Hall.

Engineer Skinner had nothing to report on the inside repairs of the Fire Station or the wrap up of the South 2nd East Street project.

There were no changes to the ongoing project list. Councilmember Hart suggested reviewing the Clerk staff succession plan in January. Councilmember Carpenter expressed his dissatisfaction with Forsgren Engineers placement of the metal for the bridge crane at the wastewater plant. He feels Forsgren has the dropped the ball on the last three projects that needed re-engineering mid-project. Engineer Skinner will stress the City's dissatisfaction with Forsgren. Director Hansen reported the new Kelly Park playground was complete with wood chips, benches and tables. In the spring the asphalt path will be installed and trees and landscaping. He thanked the Mayor and Council for their support of the project. Councilmember Hart noted how impressed he is with how well and quickly it came together and thanked Director Hansen. Councilmember Worthington noted how classy all the parks are looking with the improvements being made.

Councilmember Hart reminded and invited everyone to attend an environmental update from Bayer/P4 which representatives of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will also be in attendance at. The presentation will be at 4pm on November 8th at City Hall. He also mentioned the Greenfield Environmental Trust (former Kerr McGee/Tronox) will provide an update on their remediation plan after the 1st of the year.

Clerk Vorwaller mentioned the City will delivering turkeys to employees and committee members for Thanksgiving on November 10th and the City's annual Christmas Party has been planned for December 8th at Porter's Pub.

Councilmember Gambles moved to approve entering into executive session pursuant to I.C. 74-206(1)(e) & (f) involving matters of trade or commerce and to communicate with legal counsel regarding probable litigation. Councilmember Carpenter seconded the motion. A roll call showed the following vote:
