

Resolution 2022-1

Garbage Rates

(A Resolution Increasing Garbage Rates and Changing Calculation Method)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Soda Springs, Idaho, that effective April 1, 2022 the monthly garbage rates will be amended on the following basis.

WHEREAS, the City of Soda Springs, Idaho is authorized by section 8.08.060, Revised and Compiled Ordinances of the City of Soda Springs, Idaho to establish rate schedules for the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse within the City of Soda Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City of Soda Springs, Idaho, by and through a private contractor, does collect and dispose of garbage and refuse from residential and commercial establishments located within the City of Soda Springs, Idaho, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Soda Springs, County of Caribou, State of Idaho, as follows:

1. That it is essential and necessary to the health and public welfare of the City of Soda Springs, Idaho, that garbage and refuse collection and disposal service be provided to residential and commercial establishments within the City of Soda Springs, Idaho.
2. That residential dwellings are defined as single-family residents, apartment units, and mobile home units.
3. That commercial establishments are defined as all business, professional offices, service establishments, retail outlets, warehouses, or other business enterprises operated for pecuniary profit within the City of Soda Springs, Idaho.
4. That pursuant to Section 8.08.060, Revised and Compiled Ordinances of the City of Soda Springs, Idaho, the City does approve the following rate schedules for the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse within the City of Soda Springs, Idaho, and agrees to provide the billing service for a .20 cent per customer fee (included in the following rate schedule):

The service provider (M.R. & E., Inc.) shall regulate the type, size and quantity of containers needed per week for each customer.

Small – 90/100 gal. or shared medium/large containers	\$12.39 each

COMMERCIAL BILLING RATES

Small – 90/100 gal minimum \$15.50 each / Industrial Waste \$17.05

Medium – 300 gal. minimum Based on # of containers (See chart below)

Large – 450 gal. maximum Based on # of containers (See chart below)

Commercial customers, will be billed for the number of cans at the location times the number of pickups per week. (Ex: 3 Large X 3 pickups per week = \$298.89)
