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Hello Everyone...

Thank you for your participation in our 4th, 5th and 6th grade Girls Little League All Star Tournament. Here are a few things you need to be aware of...

All Refs and score keepers are volunteers and should be treated with respect!! Not every call is going to be called your way, please set a good example for your girls.

* Tournament will run according to high school rules except for the following exceptions:

1.) Quarters will be 8 minutes long with a continuous running clock until the last 2 minute of the game if the score is within 10 points, for a foul shot, injury or timeout.

2.) Each team will be allowed 2 timeouts per half.

3.) Full Court Press:

4th Grade will not be allowed.

5th/6th Grade - Teams are allowed to full-court press in the event that the score is less than a 10 point advantage. When the score reaches the 10 point advantage the leading team will not be allowed to full court press until the score is below 10 points. **It is considered poor sportsmanship to continue to full court press if up by more than 10 points and it will not be tolerated.**

4.) The warm-up period will be 5-8 minutes long and half time will be 3-8 minutes. Both will depend on if the tournament is running on schedule.

5.) Free Throws -

4th Grade will have a line that they will shoot from. They can touch the line but cannot cross it.

5th Grade must start at the regular foul line, they may touch it but cannot jump across it.

6th Grade - High School rules in effect. Cannot touch or cross the line.

6:) Pool play winners will be determined by points you allow your opponent.

Admission for spectators all day will be \$5. Children 8 and under are Free. There will be a variety of concessions available for purchase for your teams and patrons. Please pick up after your team. We are very fortunate that the School District will allow the Little League Program to use the facilities so please do your part in helping us keep things clean.

There will be a first and second place presentation directly following the championship game in each division. In the event that your team is in the championship game, please be prepared to announce each girl by name and present her with her metal.
