

Women's League Volleyball Rules

1. Games will be played according to High School rules, with the following exceptions:
 - a. Matches will consist of up to 3 sets.
 - First two sets will be timed for 10 minutes
 - The set will end at the end of 10 minutes or if your team reaches 25, win by 2
 - The third set, if needed, will be played to 15 and will not be timed
 - Each team is allowed one (1) time out per set; time outs do not carry over. The clock will be stopped for the timeout.
 - The clock may be stopped at the discretion of the referee for special situations (player injuries, etc).
2. Every effort will be made to start games on time.
3. All participants must be 18 and no longer in High School
4. Opposing teams will shake hands after each game
5. If there is a questionable call, the referee may choose to replay the point.
 - a. Referees may make calls that you feel are unfair or incorrect; the calls that they make are law and not up for negotiation.
6. If you are scheduled for the first game, please arrive early to help set up; if you are the last team to play, please stay and help clean-up.
7. During regular season play, if a team has less than 6 players, the opposing team will decide if that team is allowed to pull other players to play.
8. During tournament play, teams are not allowed to pull players from other teams
9. Players can only be registered to play for one team.
10. No new players can be added to the roster after the 4th week of play.
11. Players must play two nights and be on the team roster before they are eligible for tournament play
 - a. Exceptions to this rule will be assessed on a case-by-case basis
12. All participation fees will be paid by the second game. If they are not paid for, participants will not be allowed to play until the fee is paid.
- 13. No children will be allowed, with the exception of pre-crawling children. This is a liability; we do not want children hurt.**
 - a. If there are circumstances when children must attend (with a spouse, unable to find a babysitter, etc), children need to remain sitting on the bleachers. They are not allowed to play in the halls, in the lobby, on the bleachers or on the court.
