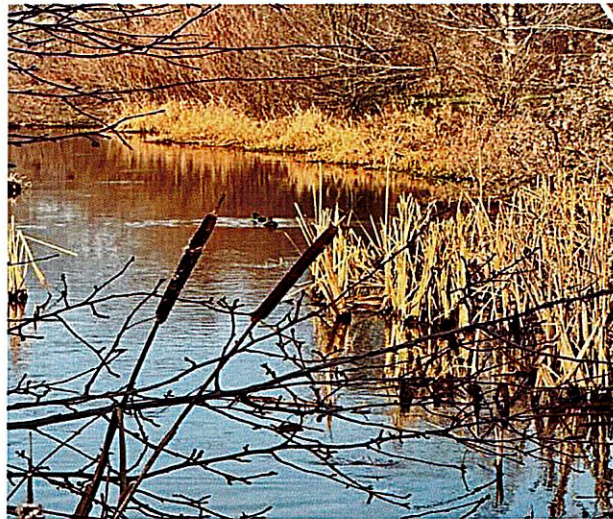

You are invited to help conserve and protect South Lyon Area ***creeks, streams, and waterways***. Please join us for the “20th Annual South Lyon Area Creek Clean-Up and Earth Day Event” being held on Sunday, April 21, 2024, from 9:00am – 1:00pm. Rain or shine. Pizza lunch and refreshments at Noon.

Volunteers - please meet at 400 McMunn Street, at the Michigan Seamless Tube and Pipe Company Truck Parking Lot in South Lyon, Michigan. Volunteers will safely remove trash and debris from South Lyon area creeks, streams, and waterways - all within the Huron River Watershed. The clean-up allows for the free flow of storm water within the City of South Lyon, Lyon Township and Green Oak Township. Free flow of water allows the streets to remain clear of water and reduces the possibility of flooding.

It is strongly encouraged to wear a bright long sleeve shirt, long pants, rubber boots and gloves. Safety vests and sanitation will be provided. Needed (not required): rakes, shovels, pick-up trucks and trailers to haul trash to dumpster.
