Garden Plots
Rules and Regulations

1. All Garden Plots will be assigned on a first come first serve basis, with preference given to City Residents.
2. All returning Gardeners will be given first preference and permitted to keep the same garden plot. Reservations must be made by calling City Hall to let us know that you are coming back.
3. Reservations will only be accepted after March 1st of the current year.
4. One garden plot per household.
5. All plots must be kept neat. If you are unable to tend to your space, please contact City Hall at: (248) 437-1735
6. If there is no evidence of activity at your assigned garden plot by June 1st, then the plot will be forfeited and assigned to another resident.
7. All garden items must be removed by November 15th of the current year. If your plot still contains non-tillable items after closure of the garden, you may not be permitted to register for a plot next year.
8. All produce must be for personal use and not sold.
