





## EXPLORE

Come and explore the Huron Valley Trail and the hidden gems that can be found in the towns surrounding this 8.5 mile long rail-trail.

### City of South Lyon

Trek into historic downtown South Lyon to shop and dine or visit the South Lyon Farmers Market and the unique Witch's Hat Depot Museum.



### Lyon Township

Pedal your way down the trail and stop into one of many local eateries in New Hudson. You can also take a short detour in Lyon Township to the nearby Michigan War Dog Memorial and pay your respects to the military and service K-9s that served alongside men and women in uniform.



### Milford Township

Stroll over to Milford Township and immerse yourself in the natural surroundings of this rural community. The Huron Valley Trail links to the Hike-Bike Trail in Kensington Metropark and north into quaint historic downtown Milford.

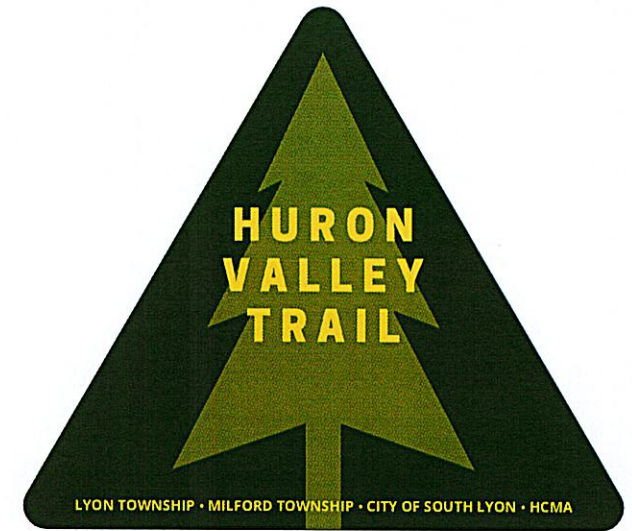
