- 2. McHattie Park Plans McLoud showed the Power Point presentation he had created for presentation at the April 26 City Council meeting. Commissioners had several suggestions which he will incorporate. Once Don Beagle sends PDF versions of the conceptual drawings depicting the park improvements the Commission is proposing, McLoud will email a final version of the presentation to all Commissioners for review.
- **3. Community Movie Projector -** Delaney stated that Milford Township has had second thoughts regarding their participation in this joint purchase. Murphy stated that if Milford Township backs out, another community will be sought to take their place or the cost would be divided among the remaining participants. If they refuse to contribute the additional funds, the purchase most likely would not occur.

4. Eagle Scout Projects – Beagle stated that there are four scouts who will be taking on projects which the Commission had identified in McHattie Park. There are potentially 6-8 additional scouts who will be needing projects in the next several months. The Commission will attempt to identify items during the park walk-throughs that could be Eagle Scout projects and add them to the master list. Beagle will attend an upcoming Historical Commission meeting to find out if they have any items which could be offered as Eagle Scout projects.
