

Minutes from Regular Meeting Held on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 7:00 PM

Minutes from February 6 meeting - corrected to reflect members present and approved.

Budget: \$500 grant from Connecticut Office of the Arts to be matched either by fundraising outreach or with funds from our budget.

Stafford Stomp is going well - this month's dance drew a large crowd. There is one more dance at the end of the month.

Summer Concert Series- approved updates to the schedule, and rain dates are confirmed, except July use of Memorial Hall - not yet confirmed. Hosting responsibilities tabled to next meeting. Cheryl made a motion to allocate up to \$200 for PR and printing for the summer concerts and for name plaques for the downtown murals.


Movie Night discussion tabled.

New business discussed was the Public Space Art Project Proposal prepared by Cheryl. We thought it looked great, and Cheryl will submit to Selectmen's Office. We also discussed the need for liability insurance for concerts in Haymarket Square sponsored by Arts on Main. The expense is prohibitive for small businesses. We will look into whether the Arts Commission can co-sponsor these activities and therefore have them covered by town insurance. We will also research how the Stafford Community Farmers Market handles liability insurance.

At 7:40, Cheryl made a motion to adjourn, Tannis seconded. No further discussion. All members in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
