Group discussed promotion of the upcoming Summer Concert Series. We reviewed the press release and shared posters and bookmarks for members to share to help publicize the concert series. In reviewing our budget we determined that we needed to move \$750 from our savings account to our budget line item to pay this year's performers. Nancy made a motion to move \$750 from our savings to balance our summer concert series budget. Rachel seconded the motion. No further discussion. Pass with unanimous agreement.

We reached out to the Hyde Park Commission to see if they would be willing to place a Porta-Potty near the amphitheater during the summer concerts.

Rich Sbardella reached out to us to ask if we will support the 2019/2020 season for Stafford Stomp. After a brief discussion regarding the strong attendance and community support for the series, Nancy made a motion that the Arts Commission continue its support of the Stafford Stomp dances over its 2019/2020 season. Reena seconded the motion. No further discussion. Passed unanimously.

Commission members discussed other topics including the vines that are hanging over the art work in the park on Main Street. Cheryl to reach out to the DPW to ask for them to be trimmed. We discussed undertaking a project to place four decorated trash barrels along Main Street. Cheryl reached out to DPW to learn about maintenance of the barrels.

Nancy made a motion to adjourn. Rachel seconded the motion. All in favor of adjournment. Meeting adjourned at 7:42 pm.
