



Minutes

1. Open Meeting
 - a. Carleton made a motion to open the meeting Oliver seconded, motion passed unanimously.
2. Establish Quorum
 - a. All members present, quorum established.
3. Public Comments
 - a. After seeing one of our open mic nights in Haymarket Common, Rey Fabrizio and Phen visited our meeting and are considering joining the commission.
4. New Business
 - a. Scarecrow
 - i. Carleton proposed having a scarecrow for the SAC – Michael seconded, the motion passed unanimously.
 1. Nancy volunteered to get more details from Patti Rossi about scarecrows
 - a. Carleton will reach out to Down to Earth farm for hay. Commission discussed various materials and the incorporation of different arts media in the design
 - b. Fall events
 - i. Open mic night – Andie proposed Sep 22. Chris seconded, motion passed unanimously.
 - ii. First Night celebration – Carleton proposed a first night celebration, but more information was needed. Tabled discussion until further in the year.
 - iii. Teri proposed guerilla art during public events. The commission discussed how this would be implemented, and what these activities would entail.
 1. One suggestion was “Color Stafford Springs,” a coloring booklet for kids with Stafford-inspired illustrations. Tabled discussion for now.
5. Old Business
 - a. Mural Proposal
 - i. Chris did not have updates on the mural proposal, but said he was working on it – currently due to Amber Wakley by Sep 08.
 - b. Midnight at 9

- i. Oliver reached out to community center to discuss hosting movies in the future. They are booked on most weeknights, but not weekends.
 - 1. Trick or Treat on Main, Oct 29, or 30th – proposed a Halloween movie night.
 - 2. Possible movie showing on Dec 17th as an option for Xmas movie
 - c. Bulletin board
 - i. Teri Herel and Brian Chevalier discussed the bulletin board to be added to the Wall Art. Carleton mentioned his discussion with Amber Wakley about potentially including a bulletin board, with a spot dedicated to Arts events in the redevelopment of the empty lot on Main St.

 - a. Carleton made a motion to close the meeting, Andie seconded, motion passed unanimously.
