George at the Marena amusement company (carnival) is no longer willing to do Summerfest. Commission to look into other companies. Burt Davis and Rick Zulick to determine if field in front of high school may be used and also determine if soccer field can be used for a hot air balloon from Re/Max, if available. If we are successful in finding a carnival company, we need signage to direct Summerfest goers to the upper field (track) where the food vendors will be located (no food vendors at the carnival).

Anybody Can Hoop is no longer in business. Caricature artist Wild Bill Taylor will be invited to attend, as will Roaming RC and Railroad, Gary Bessette the Magic Guy, Ductapestry. Last year's list of vendors will be provided to members who wish to contact and encourage participation in this year's event.

A free Cards for Soldiers table will be set up by the Commission, allowing children to create cards for the troops, to be placed in a box and forwarded to soldiers.

4H event was suggested for lower field and will be researched. The idea of CERT offering disaster kit lists was suggested. A fundraiser for CCAC was suggested, such as selling food.
