Notice is hereby given, by the Stafford Water Pollution Control Authority, that a public hearing will be held at the Stafford Senior Center, 3 Buckley Highway, Stafford Springs, Connecticut and also, via Zoom or conference call on June 21, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. to:

1. Consider a proposal to construct an additional 400 feet of sanitary sewer line to the previously approved 700 foot extension located along West Stafford Road from the end of the existing system. Plans for the addition to said system are available for inspection at the office of the Stafford Water Pollution Control Authority at 50 River Road, Stafford Springs, Connecticut.
2. Consider a proposal to amend the 'Water Pollution Control Authority Regulations for the Installation and Connection of Building Sewers and for the Use of Public Sewers in the Town of Stafford, Connecticut' to include the standard construction requirements for the sanitary sewer manhole frame detail for paving projects.


