Stafford Voting District 1, Old Town Hall is among 66 voting precincts randomly chosen by the Office of the Secretary of the State of Connecticut as a voting precinct to hold an Election Audit. The Audit will be conducted by the Registrar of Voters. The Audit will be held at 9:00 am on Tuesday, December 3, 2013 in the Community Room of the Stafford Public Library located at 10 Levinthal Run. The Audit is done to ensure the accuracy of the optical scanners used at election. A manual audit will consist of manual tabulation of the paper ballots cast and counted by each voting machine subject to audit. The vote totals established pursuant to the manual tabulation shall be compared to the results reported by the voting machines from District 1, Old Town Hall from the Municipal Election on November 5, 2013. On Thursday, November 21, 2013 at 5 pm, the Town Clerk will select by drawing the three offices to be audited at 5 pm at the Town Clerk's Office at 1 Main Street. The Public is welcome to attend.
