8.	Level 8	390,001-455,000 Gallons Per Year	2,590.00
9.	Level 9	455,001-520,000 Gallons Per Year	2,960.00
10.	Level 10	Over 520,001 will be \$5.69 per 1,000 gallons or portions thereof	
11.	Level 11	Septic Dumpings will be \$0.085 per gallon.

All charges may be paid in two equal installments. The first due July 1, 2021, and the second installment due January 1, 2022, with the exception of industries, which will be billed in four quarterly installments by the tenth (10th) day of the month at the beginning of each quarter. FAILURE TO RECEIVE ANY BILL SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE SEWER USER CHARGE OR PENALTIES ON DELINQUENT SEWER USER CHARGES. If payment is not made within one month of the due date, the installment due will become delinquent and subject to interest at the rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month from the installment due date. Minimum interest charge is two dollars (\$2). JULY INSTALLMENTS NOT PAID ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 2, 2021 ARE DELINQUENT.

All users with sewer service for less than the full fiscal year of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, shall pay a pro-rated share of the above approved sewer user charges, based on the amount of time that they have had sewer service.

Sewer User Charges may be paid at the Water Pollution Control Facility, 50 River Road, Stafford Springs, CT: Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; and Friday 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Any party aggrieved by said sewer user charges may appeal to the Superior Court for the Judicial District of Tolland, and said appeal must be taken within twenty-one (21) days after such filing.
