Regulations for renting the Staffordville Lake Pavillion

The pavilion is available for renting from May 15th – September 30^{th.} Weekends: Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am – 8:00pm & weekdays 4:00pm-8:00pm while the Recreation Program is in session (July 5, 2022 – August 12, 2022).

The fee to rent the Pavilion is non-refundable \$150.00 (rain or shine) which is due upon booking the rental date. The person who books the Pavilion is responsible for any damages to the area by anyone in their group.

Lifeguards start after the end of school in June. There is no electricity at the pavilion. Port-a-potties are available after May 15th

The rules for usage are as follows:

- 1. The pavilion area does not open until 10:00a.m. and closes at dusk.
- 2. You are allowed to use ½ the pavilion, the other half must be left open for use by residents utilizing the lake.
- 3. Open fires are **not** allowed (charcoal grills, etc.) Gas grills **are** allowed but only outside the pavilion area.
- 4. Alcohol is NOT allowed on any town property. The Police will be notified.
- 5. Glass containers should not be used if at all possible (broken glass in a beach area with bare feet is a hazard).
- 6. You are responsible for cleaning up the area of the pavilion you used (removal of trash and any decorations etc).
- 7. If a lifeguard is on duty they are in charge of the area, the rules must be followed to protect the safety of everyone at the lake. If you have children in the water the parents/adults who brought them must be supervising them. The lifeguards are there in case of an emergency, NOT TO BABYSIT.
