The Electors of the Town of Stafford are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in Stafford on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their vote for Governor and Lieutenant Governor, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller, Attorney General and Judge of Probate.
- II. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval of a proposed AMENDMENT to the Constitution of Connecticut, a vote of "YES" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "NO" being a vote for disapproval:
 1. Shall the Constitution of the State be amended to permit the General Assembly to provide for early voting?

The full text of such proposed questions with explanatory text, printed in accordance with CGS 2-230a is available at the Town Clerk's office for public distribution. The vote on the proposed question is taken pursuant to the Constitution of Connecticut.

Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling places is as follows:

Absentee Ballots will be counted centrally at Warren Memorial Town Hall, 1 Main St, Stafford. Election Day Registration (EDR) will take place at Warren Memorial Town Hall, 1 Main St, Stafford.

Voting tabulators will be used. The polls will be open at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and will remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
