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**Special Town Meeting

The Special Town Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm. by First Selectman Mary Mitta in the Veteran's Meeting Room of the Charles Warren Memorial Town Hall. Approximately 20 electors and those eligible to vote in town meetings were present. First Selectman Mitta led the assemblage in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

"I move that the Town of Stafford appropriate \$239, 655.00 from the General Fund (Cash Balance) to the Stafford Board of Education on June 1, 2019 for non-compliance with the FY 2018-2019 Minimum Budget Requirement (MBR), as recommended by the Board of Finance at their February 4, 2019 meeting."


Beth Dadalt seconded the motion.
