

**Special Town Meeting  
Town of Stafford  
August 25, 2022**

First Selectman Salverio “Sal” Titus called the Town Meeting to order promptly at 5:30 p.m. in the Veteran’s Meeting Room of the Charles Warren Memorial Town Hall. Approximately nine electors and those eligible to vote in Town Meetings were present. First Selectman Titus led the assemblage in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Richard Hartenstein, Jr. nominated Beth DaDalt as Moderator of the Town Meeting. Stephanie Irving seconded the nomination. With no other names placed in nomination, the motion passed by unanimous vote and Beth DaDalt was named Moderator of the Town Meeting.

Laura Lybarger made a motion to waive the reading of the call of the meeting which was duly published in the Journal Inquirer on August 16, 2022, and posted in the Town Clerk’s office on that same day. Richard Hartenstein, Jr. seconded the motion. Beth DaDalt called for a voice vote on the motion and declared the motion approved.

Stephanie Irving proposed the following motion:

**“I move that the Town of Stafford approve putting the Town property located at 36 Prospect Street up for sale.”**

Kathleen Prudden seconded the motion.

After a brief discussion, Moderator DaDalt stated that the realtor would market the property, the Board of Selectmen would schedule a public hearing for property proposals, and ultimately a Town Meeting would be called to approve a final sale.

Hearing no further discussion, Moderator DaDalt called for a voice vote on the motion, and declared the motion approved.

With no other business proper to come before the Town Meeting, Stephanie Irving made a motion to adjourn. Richard Hartenstein, Jr. seconded the motion. With all assembled in favor, the Town Meeting adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
