


**Town of Stafford
Special Town Meeting
May 30, 2024**

TOWN CLERK

First Selectman William Morrison called the Town Meeting to order at 6:00 pm in the Veteran's Meeting Room of the Charles Warren Memorial Town Hall in Stafford, Connecticut. Six electors and those eligible to vote in Town Meetings were in attendance. First Selectman William Morrison led the assemblage in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Richard Hartenstein, Jr. nominated William Morrison to serve as Moderator. Erin Dunn Milnes seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Town Clerk Karen G. Troiano read the call of the meeting which was duly posted on May 21, 2024 in the Office of the Town Clerk, and published in the Journal Inquirer on that same day.

Richard Hartenstein, Jr. proposed the following motion:

"I move that the Town of Stafford approve a transfer of \$45,000.00 from the Service District Savings Fund to #85-850-4125 as recommended by the Service District Commission at their April 1, 2024 meeting."

Erin Dunn Milnes seconded the motion.


Service District Secretary Erin Dunn Milnes explained to those assembled that Account # 85-850-4125 is the Trash Collection Line Item. The Town of Stafford contract for trash and recycling pick-up and disposal in the Service District had increased. The Service District Commission approved the transfer to cover the increased cost, and Town Meeting approval is required. Hearing no further discussion, Moderator Morrison called for a voice vote and declared the motion approved.

As there are no vacant terms on the Stafford Public Library Board at this time, Item #2 was not acted upon.

With adjournment as the only business left to come before the Special Town Meeting, Moderator Morrison entertained a motion by Richard Hartenstein, Jr. The motion was seconded by Erin Dunn Milnes.

The Town Meeting was adjourned at 6:03 p.m.
