

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

WHEREAS, the Nevada Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 116 (AB116), during the 2021 Legislative Session, decriminalizing certain traffic offenses from misdemeanors to civil infractions.

WHEREAS, pursuant to AB116, the Virginia Township Justice Court now has jurisdiction over juvenile offenders cited for civil infractions previously resolved by the Juvenile Court Division under the authority of the First Judicial District Court in Carson City.


THEREFORE, the First Judicial District Court and the Virginia Township find that providing authority to the judicial clerks in the Juvenile Court Division in Carson City to process juvenile civil infraction citations is in the best interest of judicial efficiency and allows juveniles the opportunity to participate in the Driving Responsibly Includes Vehicle Education (D.R.I.V.E.) Program to learn driving safety techniques.

IT IS ORDERED effective January 1, 2023, that the Virginia Township Juvenile Civil Infraction Authority Guideline (Exhibit A) is approved and shall be administered by the judicial clerks in the Juvenile Court Division in Carson City.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court Administrator ensure that the judicial clerks receive proper training to comply with AB116 prior to January 1, 2023.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that documents imaged and digitally stored in the new civil  
2 infraction case management system, Global Justice Solutions, will be deemed as original  
3 documents.
