

Virginia Township Justice Court, Virginia City, Nevada

Justice Court staff is prohibited from providing legal advice. The staff cannot tell you whether or not you should sue someone, recommend any specific attorney or law firm, give you an opinion about your case or predict how a judge might rule, talk to a judge on your behalf, or tell you what words to use in your court papers or at a court hearing.

A general Notice of Appeal is only the first step for filing an appeal. You are required to comply with all the provisions for filing an appeal. You are required to take any action necessary to enable the clerk to assemble and transmit the record to district court, including the payment of all necessary filing fees for both the justice court and district court.

For information about filing an appeal from justice court to the district court, go to the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Justice Court Rules of Civil Procedure. You are encouraged to speak with an attorney.

Fees for filing an Appeal:

- ✓ \$26.00 Filing fee payable to justice court
- ✓ \$25.00 Transmittal fee payable to justice court
- ✓ \$102.00 Filing fee payable to First Judicial District Court (separate check)
- ✓ \$100.00 SEPARATE CHECK/CASH. Deposit for transcript (*If the deposit is more than the actual cost, the remainder will be returned to you. If the deposit is less, you must pay the balance due forthwith.*)

- ✓ \$250.00 Bond for costs or you may file a supersedeas bond
