A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE TASK ORDER NO. 24-05-SCS/ENV(A) TO THE ARCHITECT/ENGINEERING AGREEMENT DATED MARCH 29, 2024, AS AMENDED, BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA AND STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES, INC. (“A/E”) FOR A/E TO PROVIDE DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS, A HYDRODYNAMIC MODELING REPORT, DESIGN AND PERMITTING SERVICES, AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT RELATED TO THE LITTLE BAYOU LAGOON RESTORATION PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$504,900; APPROVING A RESCISSION OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION IN THE STORMWATER DRAINAGE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND (4013) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$133,600 FROM THE LAKE IMPROVEMENTS FY 2023 PROJECT (19209); APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$133,600 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE STORMWATER DRAINAGE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND (4013), RESULTING FROM THE ABOVE RESCISSION, TO THE LITTLE BAYOU LAGOON RESTORATION PROJECT (21017); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (ECID PROJECT NO. 25121-130; ORACLE NO. 21017)

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg, Florida and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (“A/E”) executed an architect/engineering agreement on March 29, 2024 for A/E to provide professional services on a continuing basis for work of a specified nature as outlined in the agreement related to miscellaneous Environmental Services Projects; and

WHEREAS, the architect/engineering agreement dated March 29, 2024 has been previously amended; and

WHEREAS, Administration desires to issue Task Order No. 24-05-SCS/ENV(A) for A/E to provide data collection and analysis, a hydrodynamic modeling report, design and permitting services, and community engagement related to the Little Bayou Lagoon Restoration Project in an amount not to exceed \$504,900, which amount includes a \$50,000 allowance; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funding for this task order will be available after approval of (i) a rescission of an unencumbered appropriation in the Stormwater Drainage Capital Projects

Fund (4013) in the amount of \$133,600 from the Lake Improvements FY 2023 Project (19209) and (ii) a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$133,600 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Stormwater Drainage Capital Projects Fund (4013), resulting from the above rescission, to the Little Bayou Lagoon Restoration Project (21017).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute Task Order No. 24-05-SCS/ENV(A) to the architect/engineering agreement dated March 29, 2024, as amended, between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. ("A/E") for A/E to provide data collection and analysis, a hydrodynamic modeling report, design and permitting services, and community engagement related to the Little Bayou Lagoon Restoration Project in an amount not to exceed \$504,900.

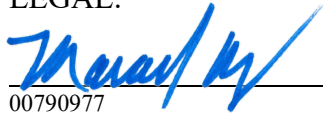

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Stormwater Drainage Capital Projects Fund (4013), resulting from the above rescission, the following supplemental appropriation for FY25:
