TO: The Honorable Gina Driscoll, Chair, and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: A resolution approving the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida (“City”) and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (“Division”) for the City to receive funding in an amount not to exceed \$148,080 as a subaward through the Division’s Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (“HMGP”); approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$148,080 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional grant revenues, to the Fire Rescue Department, Fire Suppression Division (150-1497); authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute the Agreement and all other documents necessary to receive this funding; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION: The Division received funding from the Federal government’s Federal Emergency Management Agency, and the Division has allocated funding for the reduction or mitigation of damage that might otherwise occur from severe weather or other hazards through the HMGP.

The Division has determined the City is eligible for funding in an amount not to exceed \$148,080 to purchase and install a 200KW generator and related necessary equipment and labor to provide electrical service to Fire Rescue Headquarters during power outages.

The anticipated total project cost is approximately \$185,100, and the grant will provide seventy-five percent (75%) with the City contributing the other twenty-five percent (25%).

RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends City Council approve the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the City and the Division for the City to receive funding in an amount not to exceed \$148,080 as a subaward through the Division’s HMGP, a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$148,080 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional grant revenues, to the Fire Rescue Department, Fire Suppression Division (150-1497), and authorize the Mayor or his designee to execute the Agreement and all other documents necessary to receive this funding.

COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION: Revenues on a reimbursement basis in the amount of \$148,080 will be received from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and deposited in the General Fund (0001). Funds for the city portion of the project have been previously appropriated in the General Fund (0001), Fire Rescue Department, Fire Suppression Division (150-1497). Grant funds will be available after the approval of a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$148,080 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional grant revenues, to the Fire Rescue Department, Fire Suppression Division (150-1497).

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FEDERALLY-FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA (“CITY”) AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (THE “DIVISION”) FOR THE CITY TO RECEIVE FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$148,080 AS A SUBAWARD THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM; APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$148,080 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND (0001), RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL GRANT REVENUES, TO THE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT, FIRE SUPPRESSION DIVISION (150-1497); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO RECEIVE THIS FUNDING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Division received funding from the Federal government’s Federal Emergency Management Agency, and the Division has allocated funding for the reduction or mitigation of damage that might otherwise occur from severe weather or other hazards through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (“HMGP”); and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the Fire Rescue Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, the Division has determined the City is eligible for funding in an amount not to exceed \$148,080 to purchase and install a 200kW generator and related necessary equipment and labor to provide electrical service to Fire Rescue Headquarters during power outages; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive such funding, the City must enter into the Federally Funded Sub-Award and Grant Agreement with the Division; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated total project cost is approximately \$185,100, and the grant will provide seventy-five percent (75%) with the City contributing the other twenty-five percent (25%); and

WHEREAS, Administration recommends approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the City and the Division for the City to receive funding in an amount not to exceed \$148,080 as a subaward through the HMGP is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional grant revenues, the following supplemental appropriation for FY22:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute the Agreement and all other documents necessary to receive this funding.
