

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Bedei called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF AGENDA There were no changes.

Mayor Bedei read aloud the U.S. Fair Housing Law proclaiming April 2022 U.S. Fair Housing Law month.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. ORDINANCE 2022-07. AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SURPLUS REVENUE IN THE STREATOR SOUTH INDUSTRIAL SPECIAL TAX ALLOCATION FUND AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THAT SURPLUS REVENUE TO THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY TREASURER FOR DISTRIBUTION TO AFFECTED TAXING DISTRICTS ON A PRO RATA BASIS FOR TAX YEAR 2020 PAYABLE 2021.**

Mayor Bedei requested a motion and second to adopt the above ordinance.

Mayor Bedei explained this is done annually to disperse TIF fund. We took action at the last meeting to TIF funds to LaSalle County. This is for Livingston County.

- 2. RESOLUTION 2022-10. A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$23,000 OF SUPPLEMENTAL MFT FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH ROADWAY MAINTENANCE PROJECTS FOR FY 2022 FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF STREETS AND HIGHWAYS BY THE CITY OF STREATOR UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE.**

**OF STREATOR UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE.
(2022 Emulsified Oil Supply Contract)**

CODE (2022 Aggregate Supply Contract)**

Palm explained to the Council these bids came in high due to the increased cost of materials. This was scheduled to be done this year, but I recommend seeing how the budget is coming along later in the year. This project can wait until next if necessary.

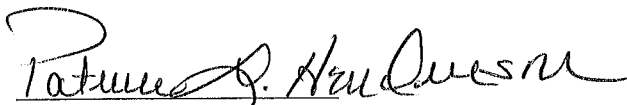
At 7:17 P.M. Mayor Bedei requested a motion and second to adjourn the meeting.
