## REQUIREMENTS FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING—SPECIAL PERMIT

### Section 10.24.111 Handicapped Parking by Special Permit (Residential)

- A. *Requirements for special handicapped parking permits in residential areas:* Special Handicapped Parking Permits for spaces upon public streets in residential areas shall be issued only upon full compliance with the term and provisions of this section. The parking, loading, unloading or standing of any vehicle in a parking space in a residential area designated by signage with a special handicapped parking permit is prohibited other than by the permit holder.
- B. *Permit requirements*
1. A resident seeking a special handicapped parking permit from the City for an on-street handicapped parking space must first submit a written application to the City Manager containing the name of the handicapped person, name of the driver of the handicapped person, if different from the handicapped person, the street address of the residence of the handicapped person and any other pertinent information as requested by the City. The application shall also be accompanied by a site plan showing the location of the street, the residence of the handicapped person and the space sought to be designated as a handicapped parking space.
  2. Persons requesting a special handicapped parking permit must be a resident of the address adjoining or within reasonable proximity of the space for which the permit is requested must provide proof of said residency in the form of a utility bill, driver's license, rental agreement or property tax bill, and must be in possession of a Disabled Person Placard ID Card or a Disabled Persons License Plate with adequate identification, as required by the Illinois Vehicle Code;
  3. No special handicapped parking permit shall be issued pursuant to this section if the applicant has off-street parking available or sufficient space which may be used for off-street parking purposes upon the applicant's premises.
  4. Abutting or affected property owners will be notified by mail prior to issuance of any special handicapped parking permit.
  5. Each request shall be reviewed by the City Engineer and Chief of Police who may recommend approval or disapproval of such special permits to the City Manager.
  6. **All special handicapped parking permits shall be issued for an annual (1 year) term and must be re-applied for sixty (60) days prior to expiration.**
  7. **The applicant, if the application for the permit is granted, shall pay to the City of Streator \$100.00 for the permit which shall help defray the cost of obtaining and erecting proper signage, road markings, and special hang tags for the vehicle.**
  8. Upon issuance of the special handicapped parking permit under this section, the City Clerk shall assign the same number to the permit and hang tag issued in connection with the parking space.
  9. Only the vehicle operated by the handicapped driver or operated on his behalf shall be allowed to park in such handicapped parking space. It shall be a violation for any vehicle to park in the handicapped parking space except for that vehicle bearing the identification number assigned to that space pursuant to the provisions of this section.
