

ORDINANCE 2021-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4.12.020C  
OF THE STREATOR MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES  
CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF LIQUOR LICENSES BY CLASS

Background Recitals

- A. The City Council of the City of Streator, pursuant to authority granted to municipalities by Section 4.1 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, may determine the number, kind, and classification of liquor licenses to be issued by City.
- B. The City Council has previously determined that it is in the interest of the community to classify and limit the number of available liquor licenses.
- C. The issuance of a liquor license is a personal privilege and cannot be issued for more than a one-year period and the City Council has the authority to decrease the number of licenses to be issued regardless of whether a renewal or an original application for a liquor license is pending.
- D. The City Council of the City of Streator has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to establish the number and class of liquor licenses available as provided for this Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STREATOR, LASALLE AND LIVINGSTON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS HEREIN.**

**Section 1:** The City Council hereby finds that the Background Recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

**Section 2:** Subsection C. of Section 4.12.020 of the Streator Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows (deletions are shown in ~~strikeout font~~ and additions are shown in ***bold italics font***):

**Section 4.12.020 Classification.**

C. The number of Class A, Class B, Class C, Class CD, and Class D licenses shall be limited as described below:

Class A:	<del>25</del> <b><i>30</i></b>
Class B:	<del>8</del> <b><i>5</i></b>
Class C:	<del>15</del> <b><i>13</i></b>
Class CD:	<del>2</del> <b><i>0</i></b>
Class D:	<del>16</del> <b><i>14</i></b>

**Section 3:** Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance nor any part thereof.


**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law and shall be incorporated into the Streator Municipal Code of Ordinances.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance does not affect prosecutions for ordinance violations committed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, does not waive any fee or penalty due and unpaid on the effective date of this Ordinance and does not affect the validity of any bond or cash deposit posted, filed or deposited pursuant to the requirements of any ordinance.


