

ORDINANCE 2021-21

AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF A PUBLIC (CITY) RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR 108' LONG 50' WIDE PORTION OF S. SHABBONA STREET LOCATED AT THE SOUTHERN DEAD END OF SHABBONA STREET SOUTH OF LUNDY STREET, STREATOR, ILLINOIS, LASALLE & LIVINGSTON, COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, a petition (Exhibit "A") by Joseph Pizzalato, 609 S. Shabbona Street, is seeking the vacation of public (City) right-of-way, the same being a portion of S. Shabbona Street located at the southern dead end of Shabbona Street south of Lundy Street in the City of Streator for the purpose to allow the sale of the adjacent properties due to the fact that the two existing garages at 608 and 609 S. Shabbona Street were built on the right-of-way over 30 years ago; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation was provided to neighboring property owners, within 250 feet of this property, (Exhibits "C" and "D"); and

WHEREAS, a sewer line exists within the right-of-way proposed for vacation so a permanent easement has been included within the vacation language; and

WHEREAS, there is no identified current or future intended public purpose, which would be served by said right-of-way, thereby causing the same to be considered surplus and not necessary to serve the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Streator.


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Streator, LaSalle and Livingston Counties, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: That said public right-of-way, heretofore dedicated for public alley purposes be vacated as legally described in the attached as (Exhibit "E") and the survey attached as (Exhibit "F").


SECTION TWO: That said vacation shall be in accordance with the codes and ordinances of the City of Streator and the laws of the State of Illinois.
