

ORDINANCE 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4.12.090
OF THE STREATOR MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING
RESTRICTIONS ON THE ISSUANCE OF LIQUOR LICENSES

Background Recitals

- A. The City Council of the City of Streator, pursuant to authority granted to municipalities by Section 4.1 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, may establish regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of liquor licenses to be issued by City.
- B. The City Council previously adopted Section 4.12.090 of the Streator Municipal Code which places restrictions on the issuance of liquor licenses to specified individuals or entities.
- C. The City Council of the City of Streator has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to amend Section 4.12.090 to be more consistent with the Liquor Control Act of 1934.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STREATOR, LASALLE AND LIVINGSTON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS HEREIN.

Section 1: The City Council hereby finds that the Background Recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2: Subsection 13. of Section 4.12.090 of the Streator Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows (deletions are shown in ~~strikeout font~~ and additions are shown in ***bold italics font***):

Section 4.12.090 Classification.

...

13. City Officials. Any law enforcing public official, any mayor or any member of the city council; and no such official shall be ***directly*** interested (***by way of example and not limitation, as an owner, shareholder, partner, LLC manager, or upper level management***) ~~in any way, either directly or indirectly,~~ in the manufacture, sale or distribution of alcoholic liquor; except that license may be granted to such an official in relation to premises which are not located within the territory subject to the jurisdiction of that official if the issuance of such license is approved by the state liquor control commission.

Section 3: Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance nor any part thereof.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law and shall be incorporated into the Streator Municipal Code of Ordinances.

Section 5: Except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all articles, chapters, and sections of the


Streator Municipal Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.
