

ORDINANCE 2022-09

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.24.120 OF THE
STREATOR MUNICIPAL CODE DESIGNATING THE
200-300 BLOCK OF NORTH EVERETT STREET AS A NO PARKING AREA
FOR THE CITY OF STREATOR, LA SALLE & LIVINGSTON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS**

Background Recitals

- A. The City of Streator, Illinois, (the “City”) is a non-home rule municipality, having all of the powers and authority granted to such municipalities pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.
- B. The City Council possesses the power to regulate the use of the City’s streets.
- C. Following a review by the City Engineer and receipt of public comment from City residents, the City Council has determined public safety will be promoted by establishing no parking areas as provided for in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Streator, LaSalle and Livingston Counties, Illinois, as follows herein.

Section 1: Recitals. The City Council hereby finds that the Background Recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2: Amendment of Section 10.24.120 to the City Code. Section 10.24.120 of the Streator Municipal Code is hereby amended to add the subsections set forth below establishing no parking areas.

KK. On the east and west sides of North Everett Street between East Kent Streets and East Hickory Streets.


Section 3: Severability. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 4: Provisions in Effect. Except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all articles, chapters and sections of the Streator Municipal Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 5: Publication and Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication, and approval as required by law.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT N Everett Street No Parking
DATE May 4, 2022

Following discussion at last month's Council meeting I reviewed the parking issue in the 200-300 block of N Everett. In my review I noted that the edge of pavement to edge of pavement width was only 24' which does not allow for a minimum thru lane width of 10' in each direction with an 8' parking lane width as would be appropriate for a neighborhood collector street as N. Everett is classified. Additionally, I noted that all the homes in the area have a driveway or alley access and on-street parking is available on Kent Street and Elm Street.

As a result of this it is being recommended that the Council consider establishing no parking areas along the 200-300 block of N Everett to ensure emergency vehicle and snow plowing access. If the Council wishes to proceed with this, we can notice the action and have an ordinance drawn up.
