AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF TARBORO, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Tarboro has been petitioned under G.S. 160A-31 to annex the area described below; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has certified the sufficiency of the petition, and a public hearing on the question of this annexation was held at the Tarboro Town Hall at 7 P.M. on October 10, 2022, after due notice by publications on September 29, 2022 and October 6, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Tarboro finds that the area described therein meets the standards of G.S. 160A-31;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Tarboro further finds that the petition is otherwise valid and that the public health, safety, and welfare of the Town of Tarboro and of the area proposed for annexation will be best served by annexing the area described;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Tarboro, North Carolina that:

Section 1. By virtue of the authority granted by G.S 160A-31, the following described contiguous territory is hereby annexed and made part of the Town of Tarboro, as of October 10, 2022:

BEING the full contents of Tract 2B, containing approximately 6.45 acres, as depicted on that plat recorded in Plat Book 13, Page 256, Edgecombe County Registry.

Together with and including all rights and easements appurtenant to the foregoing-described property in and to (i) Encroachment and Reciprocal Easement Agreement, recorded in Book 1384, Page 1103, effected by that First Amendment to Encroachment and Reciprocal Easement, recorded in Book 1389, Page 1071, Edgecombe County Registry; (ii) those Easements with Covenants and Restrictions recorded in Book 1242, Page 716, Edgecombe County Registry; and (iii) that Declaration of Ingress/Egress Easement recorded in Book 1242, Page 706, Edgecombe County Registry.

- Section 2. Upon and after October 10, 2022 the above-described territory and its citizens and property shall be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances, and regulations in force in the Town of Tarboro and shall be entitled to the same privileges and benefits as other parts of the Town of Tarboro. Said territory shall be subject to municipal taxes according to G.S. 160A-58.10.
- Section 3. The Mayor of the Town of Tarboro shall cause to be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Edgecombe County and in the office of the Secretary of State at Raleigh, North Carolina, an accurate map of the annexed territory, described in Section 1 above, together with a duly certified copy of this ordinance. Such map shall also be delivered to the County Board of Elections, as required by G.S. 163-288.1.
- Section 4. Notice of adoption of this ordinance shall be published once, following the effective date of annexation, in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Tarboro.





Edgecombe County for many years has been a wholesale customer of water and sewer services from the Town of Tarboro. In order to outline and update the terms of this wholesale arrangement, Town Staff has worked with County Staff to draft an updated Water and Sewer Purchase Contract. The contract, among other terms, authorizes Edgecombe County to purchase up to 750,000 gallons of water from the Town and for the Town to treat up to 400,000 gallons of sewer on a daily basis.

It is recommended that the Town Council authorize the Mayor to execute the attached Water and Sewer Purchase Contract between the Town of Tarboro and Edgecombe County.

WATER AND SEWER PURCHASE CONTRACT

NORTH CAROLINA

CONTRACT BETWEEN
THE TOWN OF TARBORO
AND
EDGECOMBE COUNTY WATER & SEWER

EDGECOMBE COUNTY

This CONTRACT, for the sale and purchase of water and sewer, is entered into this the 10th day of October, 2022, by and between The Town of Tarboro, party of the first part, hereinafter referred to as the "Town" (seller) and Edgecombe County, party of the second part, hereinafter referred to as the "County", (purchaser).

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the **County** is organized and established under the provisions of Article 2 of Chapter 153A of the North Carolina General Statutes; and the **County** under authority of said Article of said Chapter of the North Carolina General Statutes will operate a water and sewer distribution and collection system, serving water and sewer users within the county in areas described by plans on file in the office of the Edgecombe County Water and Sewer Department, Edgecombe Administration Building, 201 St. Andrew St., Tarboro, North Carolina 27886, and to exercise this authority, the County requires a supply of treated water and collectible sewer; and

Whereas, the Town is organized and established under the provisions of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes; and the Town owns and operates a water treatment and sewer treatment system with a capacity currently capable of serving the present customers of the **Town** with additional capacity available to the **County**; and

Whereas, by resolution adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Tarboro on 10th day of October, 2022, the sale of water and sewer to the County in accordance with the provisions in this Water and Sewer Purchase Contract was approved, and the execution of this contract carrying out said resolution by the Mayor and attested by the Town Clerk, was duly authorized; and

Whereas, by Resolution adopted by the Edgecombe County Board of Commissioners, on the <u>3rd</u> day of <u>October, 2022</u>, the

purchase of water and sewer from the Town of Tarboro in accordance with the terms as set forth in this Water and Sewer Purchase Contract, was approved and the execution of this contract carrying out said resolution by the Chairman of the Edgecombe County Board of Commissioners and attested by the clerk, was duly authorized;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements herein set forth, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The Town Agrees:

- a. Quantity and Quality: To furnish the County at the points of delivery hereinafter specified during the term of this contract or any renewal or extension thereof, potable treated water meeting applicable purity standards of the rules governing public water supplies, 15A NCAC 18C Water Supplies, in such quantity as may be required by the County not to exceed 750,000 gallons per day. In the event of a break in the County's water system or other emergency, the County is obligated to immediately contact the Town's Utility personnel and inform them of their estimates of the daily usage. Each of the parties hereto shall immediately notify the other of an emergency or condition, which may affect the quality or quantity of water in either party's system.
- b. <u>Sewer Services</u>: To furnish the <u>County</u> at the points of delivery hereinafter specified during the term of this contract or any renewal or extension thereof, treatment of raw sewage not to exceed 400,000 gallons per day.
- c. <u>Point of Delivery and Pressure</u>: That water will be furnished at a reasonably constant residual water pressure actually measured at not less than 55 psi from supply mains provide by the <u>Town</u> at points designated as <u>Meter Point 1</u> located at the crossing of small creek, tributary to the <u>Tar River</u>, and <u>US Highway 258</u> south of Sara Lee Road (SR 1344);

Meter Point 2 located at the intersection of McNair Road (SR 1207) and US Highway 64 Alternate;

Meter Point 3 located on the west bank of the Tar River and its intersection with US 64 Bypass and US 258 along Sewer Plant Road (SR 1629);

Meter Point 4 located at the intersection of East Northern Blvd. and St. Andrew St.

Meter Point 5 located at the "Y" of NC Highway 111-122 South and McKendree Church Road (SR 1006);

Meter Point 6 located at the southwest corner of the "round-a-bout" at Albemarle Avenue and N. Main Street, just before the Tar River Bridge.

Also, The Town agrees to permit the County to connect to the Town's sewer outfall line at a manhole on the Tar River adjacent to the Quigless Clinic. The location of said manhole is to be designated by the Public Works Director for the Town of Tarboro.

Meter Point 1 a wastewater flowmeter located at Riverview Street in Princeville, more specifically, at the "In The Curve" sewer lift station. Wastewater flowmeter, owned by the County, shall be maintained to within 2% accuracy. The flowmeter shall be calibrated bi-annually at a minimum at the expense of the County.

In the event that the **Town** chooses to install an additional wastewater flowmeter, the wastewater flowmeter, owned by the **Town**, shall be installed and maintained to within 2% accuracy and repaired as necessary at a mutually agreeable and accessible location by the **Town** and **County**. The additional flowmeter shall be calibrated bi-annually at a minimum at the expense of the **Town**.

d. Metering Equipment: To operate and maintain at its own expense at the point or points of delivery the necessary metering equipment as furnished and installed by the County in accordance with the Town's specifications, including a meter house or pit and required devices of standard type for properly measuring the quantity of water and delivered to the County, and to calibrate such metering equipment whenever requested by the County, but no more frequently than once every twelve months, a meter registering not more than 2% above or below 100% will be deemed to be accurate. The previous readings of any meter disclosed by the test to be inaccurate shall be corrected for the three (3) months previous to such test in accordance with the percentage of inaccuracy found by such test. If any meter fails to register for any period of time, the water furnished for such period shall be deemed to be the amount of water delivered in the corresponding period of time immediately prior to the failure, unless the Town and the County shall agree upon a different amount. The metering equipment shall be read monthly by the Town according to the Town's prevailing meter reading schedule. An official of the County shall have access to the meter for the purpose of verifying its reading at any reasonable time. The County may also

- install its own reading equipment as to be able to obtain daily readings from the metering equipment, as long as it does not disturb or alter the reading equipment provided by the **Town**.
- e. <u>Billing Procedure</u>: To furnish the **County** at the above address, no later than the 10th of each month with an itemized statement of the amount of water and sewer furnished to the County during the preceding month.

2. The County Agrees:

- a. Rates and Payment Date: To pay the Town no later than the past due date posted on the statement for water and sewer furnished, which said past due date shall be at least 10 days but no more than 20 days after the date of the statement for water and sewer delivered in accordance with the Town's Municipal Resale Water and Sewer Schedule.
 - 1. Water and Sewer rates charged by the **Town** to the **County** shall be no greater than the prevailing lowest wholesale rate charged by the Town to its other customers who purchase water and sewer for resale.
- b. Installation and Ownership of Meter(s): To act as the Town's agent to design, bid and construct the necessary water and sewer main extensions and metering equipment at the prescribed and agreed to points of delivery. The Town shall provide all specifications necessary for the County to meet its obligation hereunder. Upon satisfactory completion and acceptance of the water and sewer main extensions and meters, title to the ownership of the water and sewer main extensions and meters and associated real property shall be conveyed to the Town.

3. IT IS FURTHER MUTUALLY AGREED between the Town and the County as follows:

- a. <u>Terms of Contract</u>: That this contract shall extend for a term of 20 years, with an expiration date of the year 2042, from the date of the acceptance date of contract and executed by the <u>Town</u> and <u>County</u> and thereafter may be renewed or extended upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the <u>Town</u> and <u>County</u>.
- b. Failure to Deliver: The Town, at all times, shall operate and maintain its system in an efficient manner and will take such action as may be necessary to furnish the County with quantities of water and sewer required by the County as stated herein. Temporary or partial failures to

- deliver water and sewer be remedied with all possible dispatch. In the event of extended shortage of water and sewer or the supply of water and sewer available to the **Town** is otherwise diminished over an extended period of time, the supply of water and sewer to the **County's** customers shall be reduced or diminished in the same ratio or proportion as the supply to the **Town's** customers is reduced or diminished.
- c. Modification of Contract: That the provision of this contract pertaining to volume of water and sewer to be furnished to the County may be renegotiated by the County by written notice given to the Town within sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of said modifications, that the provisions of this contract pertaining to the schedule of rates to be paid to the Town for water and sewer delivered are subject to modification at the end of every year-period, generally coinciding with annual budget preparation and may be modified by the Town by written notice to the County given at least sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of said modification; provided, however, that any and all increases shall be subject to the rate limitations set forth in paragraph 2(a)1. Further, it is mutually agreed that the duration of this agreement is such that the passage of time will require modification(s) thereof. Therefore, requests by either party for modifications of this agreement shall be submitted in written form to the other party at least ninety (90) days prior to the effective date of the modifications requested, but no such modification shall be permitted except upon mutual consent of both parties.
- d. Regulatory Agencies: That this contract is subject to such rules, regulations, or laws as may be applicable in similar agreements in this State, and the Town and County will collaborate in obtaining such permits, certificates, of the like as may be required to comply herewith.
- e. <u>Successor to the County:</u> In the event of any occurrence rendering the <u>County</u> incapable of performing under this contract, any successor of the <u>County</u>, whether the result of legal process, assignment or otherwise, shall succeed to the rights of the <u>County</u> hereunder.
- f. Governing Agent: No officer or agent of the Town of County, other than the Town Council or the governing body of the County, shall have the power to amend, modify, or alter this agreement, or in any way waive any condition or to bind Town or County or make any promise or representation not contained herein.

- g. Pass Through of Water and Sewer: It is understood and agreed by both parties Hereto that the County shall not pass through the Town's water and sewer network any water and sewer unless its pass through is approved by the Town in writing prior to its occurrence. In the event of emergency situation as defined in paragraph 3(j) below, a pass through of water and sewer may be permitted in accordance with the provisions of said paragraph.
- h. Responsibility for Quality: It is distinctly understood and agreed by both parties hereto that the Town's obligation is to provide a quality of water meeting the North Carolina Drinking Water Act Regulations to the point of delivery to the County. The County shall be solely responsible for the quality and for any required testing under parameters required by the North Carolina Drinking Water Act Regulations beyond the point of delivery.
- i. Water & Sewer Policies and Water Ordinances of the Town of Tarboro: It is understood and agreed by both parties that the County shall be subject to all policies and ordinances of the Town of Tarboro, North Carolina, which relate to the subject matter of this contract; and any other such policy or ordinance provisions now existing or hereafter implemented. If a policy or ordinance directly conflicts with any provisions of this contract, then the provision of this contract shall control.
- j. Emergency Situation: Not withstanding any other provisions of this contract, in the event of an emergency situation created by unexpected events beyond the control of either party, the Town Manager or his designee on behalf of the Town and the County Manager or his designee on behalf of the County may agree to a modification or alteration of the terms of this contract in order to address the emergency situation. Any such modifications or changes shall continue in effect as long as the emergency continues to exist or the governing board of either party directs its discontinuance, whichever occurs earlier.
- k. Address for Notice: Whenever notice or information is to be furnished by the Town to the County, it shall be personally delivered or mailed to the County Manager at the Edgecombe County Administrative Building, 201 St. Andrew St., P.O. Box 10 Tarboro, NC 27886. Whenever notice or information is to be furnished by the County to the Town, it shall be personally delivered or mailed to

- the Town Manager at 500 Main St., P.O. Box 220, Tarboro, NC 27886-0220.
- 1. Service Area: Because of the cost of the installation of water and sewer systems referred to herein and in the interest of a reasonable rate being offered to the customers, both parties agree not to invade the services area of the other party as reflected on the official legal boundary description of the County for the purpose of selling water and/or sewer, unless by mutual consent of both parties. Where such extensions may be made by one party in the other party's service area, the offending party shall abide by the prevailing policies and ordinances of the offended party as it relates to size, type, and quality of water and sewer main installed. However, the responsibility for extensions and ownership of facilities within the County's boundary and/or the Town's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction shall not preclude, by special agreement for the extension of water and/or sewer mains therein, sharing the cost of making such extensions and retaining and or sharing in the ownership thereof.

4-Hold Harmless:

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the **County** shall indemnify and hold harmless the **Town**, **Town Council** and **Town Employees** from and against any and all cost, losses and damages (including but not limited to all fees or engineers, attorneys and other professionals) caused by the failure to provide water and sewer in accordance with this agreement providing that such failure is not a direct result of negligence or malice by the **Town**.

Wherefore, each of the parties hereto has caused this Agreement to be executed in its respective Corporate name by its duly authorized respective officers in duplicate originals, one of which is to be retained by each of the parties, the said day and year first above written.
