Meeting adjourned.



#### RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF TARBORO

#### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, Austin Heirs, Inc. recorded a subdivision map of a subdivision in Edgecombe County known as Stafford Forest, Section 3-A, in PC 1-167-A, Edgecombe County Registry "Recorded Map"; and

**WHEREAS**, on the Recorded Map Austin Heirs, Inc. dedicated to the public a road labeled "Cowper Street"; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Cowper Street has not been constructed; and

**WHEREAS**, this portion of Cowper Street has not been used by the public, nor has its dedication to the public been accepted by the appropriate governmental authorities, and thus all public rights in said property have been abandoned; and

**WHEREAS**, the owners of the property bordering Cowper Street. desire, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 136-96, to file a Declaration to Withdraw that portion of the land labeled "Cowper Street" on the Recorded Map that is located on Sherwood Avenue; and
