# 7. MATTERS SCHEDULED FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Proposed Golf Cart Operation Ordinance - A public hearing will be held to receive public input on the merits of establishing an ordinance for golf cart operation within the city limits of Tarboro and the inclusion of any additional restrictions that would make the ordinance safe as possible.

Councilman Braxton - thanked line workers and telecommunicators for their service.

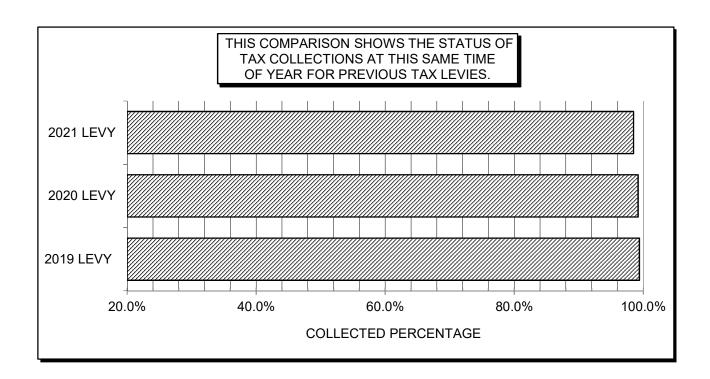

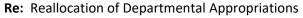

In May 2020, the Town entered into an agreement with Four Seasons Contractors in accordance with the Residential Development Investment found in Chapter 17, Article 1, Section 17-2 of the Tarboro Code of Ordinances. The agreement applies to the development of the subdivision known as Cambridge Commons Phase II.

The agreement authorizes the Town to reimburse the contractor up to fifty percent of the total cost of water, sewer, and street improvements, not to exceed \$495,000, based on actual costs. Such reimbursement will be made on a per-structure basis upon the issuance of a certificate of occupancy.

In May 2022, a budget amendment was approved for the project in its entirety, however, the 2022 purchase order was mistakenly not re-encumbered in October of this year allowing for the completion of the reimbursements. It is necessary to amend the budget to re-encumber the purchase order and finalize the reimbursements.
