### JOB OPPORTUNITY

The Town of Tarboro Electric Department has a position open depending on the candidate's experience for one (1) of the following:

**Apprentice Power line Technician** (Salary \$40,870) this person will perform electric line maintenance and construction work.

**Power line Technician I** (Salary \$45,058) this person will perform technical work in the installation, maintenance and repair of underground/overhead lines.

**Power line Technician II** (Salary \$47,310) this person will perform PL Technician I duties as well as participate in the installation of power line and alignment of power line poles, stringing primary and secondary lines, attaching wire to insulators and cross arms, installing, repairing, and replacing cross arms, supports, insulators, lighting arresters and fuse cutouts.

**Power line Technician III** (Salary \$52,158) this person must be able to perform advanced journeyman level work in the installation, maintenance and repair of underground/overhead electric lines. This position requires the following skills: Working with energized primary and secondary voltages, ability to climb wood poles, knowledge of standard electric line construction practices and be able to operate various pieces of equipment just to name a few.

**Lead Lineman** (Salary \$54,767) this person is required to observe and evaluate the work of the crew members and provide necessary training to members of the crew. This position requires the following skills: Must have considerable knowledge of the safety requirements and possible hazards involved in power line work. Independent judgment is exercised to determine the most appropriate methods and equipment when working with high voltage wires. Work requires holding lead call and frequent on-call and call-back responsibilities.

All of these positions will be required to operate equipment and power line tools. A high school diploma or GED and a valid NC Driver's license are required to apply. Candidate will need to obtain a NC Commercial driver's license within six months of employment if they do not already possess them. Upon hire, practice time for CDL will be allotted if necessary. No experience is necessary and the Electric Department is willing to train. Candidate must live within 30 minutes from the corporate limits of the Town. The Town of Tarboro has excellent benefits.
