



## **BRAZOS RIVER AUTHORITY ISSUES STAGE 1 DROUGHT WATCH FOR LAKE GRANGER**

The Brazos River Authority has implemented Stage 1 Drought Watch Condition for Lake Granger. This includes Taylor, Thrall, Jonah Water SUD and Lone Star Regional Water Authority. BRA is asking for consumers to **voluntarily** reduce water usage by 5%.

The City of Thrall will reduce flushing of water mains and reduce irrigation of public landscape lands. The city will comply with the voluntary water conservation under Stage 1 Drought Watch.

### **VOLUNTARY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS:**

1. Water customers are requested to **voluntarily** limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to 2 times per week. Please water only between Midnight and 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. to Midnight to reduce evaporation.
2. Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.
