**MINUTES:**

**BUDGET:**

The Board was briefed by Dollison on the current budget; Is in good standing. Paulk made the motion to accept the budget; seconded by Kimbrough; all approved, budget accepted.

**GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS:**

**FELON LIST;** Holley reported that were 7 cancellations and no challenges.

**APPROVED 2022 BUDGET;** We have a copy of the new and it starts July 1<sup>st</sup>.

**STEPHANIE MCKEE SWEARING IN DOCUMENTS;** Received all documents from SOS and presented to McKee.

**CITY OF TIFTON RESOLUTION FOR PACKAGE SALES;** See attachment. Once it is adopted it will be sent to SOS to put on the ballot. It is just for the City of Tifton residents to vote on.

**MUNICIPAL STREET LIST MAINTENANCE;** The street list was sent to all cities. Omega and TYTY street has been received. Changes have been made for Omega in Enet in the redistricting process. Redistricting was required because voters are attached to the streets. TYTY had no changes.

**ETHICS REPORTS;** CCDR'S are due June 30<sup>th</sup>, this report has a 5-day grace period and PFDS are due July 1<sup>st</sup> with not grace period. All candidates have been notified. Dollison stated that this is a courtesy to the candidates.

**REGIONAL ETHICS TRAINING;** We have ethics training on July 29<sup>th</sup> Valdosta. There is a new reporting site to upload all reports.

**PRECINCT CHANGES AND WAIT TIMES 21-2-263;** Based on this code section and our last discussion and Mr. Perry extensively reviewed the ruling. It was decided that we would add more machines oppose to splitting precincts. This would be best course of action for the voters and us. In addition, since acquiring the origami carts we would have the room to add more machines at each precinct.




With no further business Taylor made a motion to adjourn; and Kimbrough seconded.




