Dollison said that we may need new Poll Workers. The Plight Organization want to be represented next Election. They did not receive any money for the last election because no member worked in the June 9<sup>th</sup> Election.

**NOVEMBER ELECTION SETUP:**

Dollison told the Board the Joey will be coming by in a week or so to discuss detail for the November Election. We need more inside boards made for the signs. Ken at the county shop made a new sign for the Omega Clubhouse.


**ORIGAMI RACK FOR VOTING MACHINES:**



Meeting Adjourned




