

**TIFT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION  
BOARD MEETING  
Tuesday – May 28, 2019 (Rescheduled for May 27<sup>th</sup>)**

**SUPERINTENDENT-** Paulk called the meeting to order.

**MINUTES:**

Paulk asked Taylor to read the minutes out loud. Each Board member signed the minutes; Kimbrough made a motion to approve the minutes; Robinson seconded; all of the members agreed and the minutes were approved and accepted.

**BUDGET:**

The Board was briefed by Dollison on the current budget; Dollison stated that we were in good standing since overages were cleared up. Taylor made a motion to approve the budget; seconded by McKee; all approved, budget accepted.

**GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS:**

Paulk asked Dollison to address the next agenda item; Easy Vote Installation; was installed on May 6, everything went fine. The only thing that was an issue was the scanners we ordered would not work. Kasey is going to check them out before sending them back. The Board discussed the upcoming City Election and agreed to charge the Easy Vote installation fee to City. Kimbrough made a motion and Robinson seconded; all approved and Easy Vote installation fee to the City was accepted.

Paulk moved on to the next agenda item; Felon List; Shekia stated we are still waiting on the changes to Enet. The training is on June 5.

The next item on the agenda is the Municipal Street List. Dollison stated she emailed the street list to each city on May 8<sup>th</sup>. The sign off sheet is due back in our office on June 28<sup>th</sup>. Dollison further stated that she heard from the Danny from the City's Code Enforcement department that they do have some streets that will need to be changed.

The next agenda item is the reappointment of Thad Paulk; Dollison stated the reappointment letter was sent to Judge Reinhardt on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Paulk asked Dollison to address the next agenda item; NCOA- National Change of Address will be mailed the end of May costing us \$627.20. Dollison informed the Board that the budget has been adjusted to cover the cost.

Paulk moved on to the next agenda; Early voting office help. Margaret has agreed to work the three weeks before early voting as she always does, but this will be her last time. She only wants to work during early voting. She has agreed to help train someone to do it. Dollison stated she has approached Mary Foster about

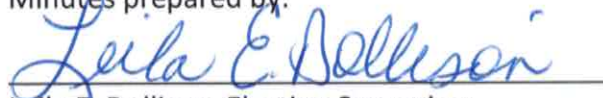
taking her place. With much discussion the Board agreed they would be thinking of someone to replace Margaret.

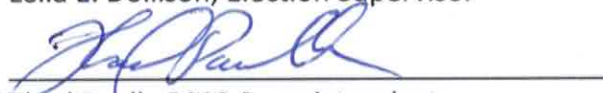

With no further business Taylor made a motion to adjourn; and Robinson seconded.

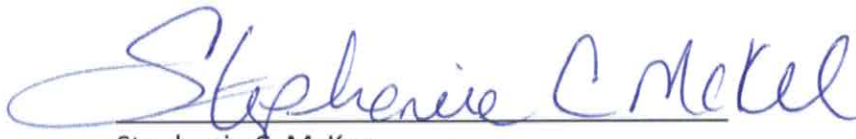

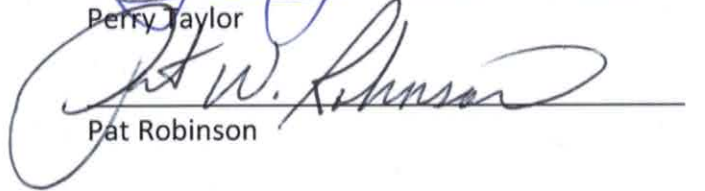
