

**TIFT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION
BOARD MEETING
MONDAY- MAY 26, 2020**

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: ROBINSON, TAYLOR, KIMBROUGH, MCKEE, PAULK

ATTENDEES PRESENT:

SUPERINTENDENT- Kimbrough called the meeting to order.

MINUTES: Kimbrough asked Taylor to read the minutes aloud. Meetings were cancelled for March 23rd and April 27th. Each Board Member read and signed the minutes; Robinson made a motion to approve the minutes; Paulk seconded; all members agreed and the minutes were approved and accepted.

BUDGET: Dollison stated that we have long since gone over our budget for the county. Kimbrough asked for a show of hands to approve or not approve the budget. No hands shown for disapproval. Taylor made a motion to accept the budget; Robinson seconded. The budget was approved.

GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS:

Kimbrough moved on to the next item on the agenda; Poll workers and Poll worker training was next. Northwest, Mott-litman, and Docia were precincts that needed managers. Kenneth Smith was considered going to Docia, Jimmy Cole possibly goes to Mott-litman. McKee was asked to go to Northwest. Wesland and Gary from Dominion would be available to check on precincts and do troubleshooting. The expectation of an increase of cancelling ballots on Election Day was discussed. This would be time consuming because precincts would have to call the Election Office to cancel each voter. This is to prevent voters from voting twice. Robinson and Paulk will further discuss training amongst each other.

Constitution Party Poll Watcher appointment was next on the agenda. There will be 2 Poll watchers for Tift County.

The Personal Protection Grant was discussed. The Election office had already received the protective shields. We will be reimbursed \$3000 of the \$4000 back in a matter of weeks. Solution for cleaning the stylus will be sent. We have masks, gloves, and cloths available for all Polling Places.


Felon List was addressed next. There were no matters concerning the Felon list.


Early voting numbers and absentee numbers was discussed next on the agenda. Dollison stated there were 533 early voters, 4612 mailed, and 2231 accepted so far.


Kimbrough asked if there was any other business from the board. There was no further business. Taylor made a motion to close the meeting; Robinson seconded. Meeting was adjourned.


