SUPERINTENDENT- Kimbrough called the meeting to order.

MINUTES:

Kimbrough asked Taylor to read the minutes out loud. Each Board Member read and signed the minutes; Robinson made a motion to approve the minutes; Paulk seconded; all of the members agreed and the minutes were approved and accepted.

BUDGET:

The Board was briefed by Dollison on the current budget; Dollison stated that the budget was in good standing. Paulk made the motion to accept the budget; seconded by Robinson; all approved, budget accepted.

GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS:

Kimbrough moved on to the next item on the agenda; Reappointment of Perry Taylor. Taylor was sworn in by Suzanne Carter Johnson and received his documents. His appointment should have taken place in April.

Board Terms and Appointments. Dollison provide a list term dates and appointments for each Board Member.

Dollison informed the Board that Poll worker training is set for September 29th through October 1st.

Absentee Ballot Printing- Dominion will mail ballots until October 16th after that we will have to mail them ourselves.

Dollison discussed Error in November Database. SOS hopes to get it corrected as soon as possible. We have not started L&A yet.

Dollison informed the Board that we ordered a ballot drop to be installed in front of the Admin building. It will be available 24 hours with surveillance. We will submit the grant and only pay \$500 for the box.

Kimbrough moved to the next item on the agenda: Ballot Trax- is a new way voters can track their ballot.




With no further business Taylor made a motion to adjourn; and Paulk seconded.






