Mayor Julie Smith called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM.

Approval of the Agenda

Attorney Rob Wilmot requested to add Mandatory Mediation Update to the agenda. Council Member Folk motioned for approval of the agenda with the addition. Motion seconded by Hall and unanimously approved.

Resolution Requiring Masks in City Owned or Leased Facilities

City Attorney Rob Wilmot presented the proposed resolution and reviewed its contents with Council. Mr. Wilmot reviewed the posting and notification requirements that must be made to the public. Council discussed when masks would be required by personnel and agreed that masks must be worn in public areas, when interacting with the public, and when the recommended six feet distance could not be achieved.

Council Member Terrell arrived to the meeting during discussion. Council Member Folk made the first motion to adopt the resolution, motion seconded by Terrell, and unanimously approved.

Mandatory Mediation Update

Mr. Wilmot gave an update on the service delivery order filed by Tift County and all municipalities. He mentioned Judge McDaniel has been assigned to the case and he has signed the order for stay and abeyance of the City's sanctions. Mr. Wilmot stated the judge's order was filed and sent to DCA for reinstating the City's qualified local government status (QLG). He furthered that the City and County would need to move forward with selecting a mediator and participate in the mandatory mediation process.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 12:30 PM.
